■ The Importance of the Study of Geography

- ✓ Intellectual Understanding of the Bible's narrative...
- ✓ Geography, history, and religion are so intricably bound together in the Bible that the religious message cannot be understood w/o attention to the setting and conditions of the revelation
- ✓ Christianity rests upon the affirmation that a series of events happened, in which God revealed Himself in action, for the salvation of man.

■ How do we know where to locate a site?

- ✓ Determine the occurrences of the site name in literary sources.
 - ✓ Distances, proximity to other sites, on/near routes
 - ✓ Other geographical indicators.
- ✓ Toponymy(What does the site name means)
- ✓ Tradition (Patristic, Talmud, Byzantine, Crusader)

■ Israel's geopolitical importance

- ✓ Land b/w 3 continents
 - Africa, Asia & Europe
- ✓ Land b/w the Desert and the Sea
 - ✓ Travel, Trade, Buffer zone(Defensive zone of protection, Launching pad(Extension of supply lines from home))

How God uses Israel's Geopolitical location?

(Ezk 5:5-8)

- ✓ A small land but coveted by “big power” as an important commercial/military hub.
- ✓ Ultimately the inhabitants of this land must look to God for security
- ✓ Primary discipline for unfaithfulness
 - ✓ Deut 4:27; 28:63-64
(The Lord will scatter you among people)
 - ✓ 2 Kings 17:5-7
 - ✓ 2 Chr 36:15-20
- ✓ God set his children Israel in a location that could be easily taken





Regional Variety

- A land of various segregated tribes and races
 - ✓ At the time of Conquest
 - ✓ Amorite, Perizzites, Hivites, Gergashites, Hittites, Canaanites, Jebusites
 - ✓ Israel maintained its own tribal distinctions for years
 - ✓ The brief period of unification under David and Solomon did not survive
 - ✓ Segmented governmental control at the time of Jesus
 - ✓ Herod Antipas, Herod Philip, Pilate, Decapolis, Samaritans
 - ✓ ToDay's medley of people
 - ✓ Religious Jews, secular Jews, Arab Muslims, Arab Christians, Other Christians, Bedouin

Regional Variety

■ Problems

- ✓ Difficult to unify and control various segmented regions within Israel
- ✓ A strong central government is difficult to establish here
- ✓ Israel was never unified (Except under David, Solomon & hasmoneans)
- ✓ Often a "peace" agreement b/w 2 parties will cause concern for a 3rd party
 - ✓ Israel + Phoenicia (Ahab+Jezebel) ↔ Damascus
 - ✓ Israel + Lebanon ↔ Syria (King Assad)
 - ✓ Israel + PLO ↔ Jordan (King Hussein)
- ✓ Future : Under Messiah, local unification will materialize
 - ✓ Isa 2:1-4; 11:12-16; 19:23-24
 - ✓ Zech 2:11-12; 9:10, Hag 2:6-9

- **Covenant & Land**
 - The fulfillment of the promised land was realized.
- **The ban**
 - Definition: Consecrate something or someone as a permanent and definitive offering for the sanctuary; in war, consecrate a city and its inhabitants to destruction; carry out this destruction; totally annihilate a population in war; kill
 - Make no treaty & show them no mercy
(Deut 7:1-11, 20:10-18)
 - Joshua obeyed (Jos 6:17-19)
 - Reason : Wickedness of the people, Protect His people from the wicked people
- **Sovereign Intervention**
 - God fights
 - Miracle: Crossing Jordan(3), falling down of Walls of Jericho (6), Controls Victory and defeat(7:1f), Sun standing still(10:12-14)

- ✓ Teaches us the significance of Christ's death—"the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." (John 1:29)







- ✓ What was a Judge?
 - ✓ Primarily military role to stop foreign aggression against the nation
 - ✓ Advisory(Counsel) (Jud 4:4-5)
 - ✓ Judge
 - ✓ They did not seek to occupy a spiritual role.
 - ✓ Gideon (Jud 8:27: foreign worship)
 - ✓ Jeptha (Jud 11:30-40: child sacrifice)
 - ✓ Samson (Jud 14-16: Cavorting w/ woman)

Study it carefully, and obey it
- ✓ He is to be a humble man



Saul

- ✓ Benjaminite
- ✓ Samuel anoints Saul→Leader (1 Sam 10:1)
- ✓ Chosen as a King in Mizpah (1 Sam 10:24)
- ✓ War against Ammon in Jabesh Gilead (1 Sam 11:1-11)
 - ✓ Establish his kingship
- ✓ Disobedience
 - ✓ Burnt offering in Gilgal: (1 Sam 13:8-14)
 - ✓ War against Amalekites (1 Sam 15:3)
- ✓ Result (1 Sam 15:28)
 - ✓ Has given it to one of your neighbors—to one better than you



David
